DRESS CODE FOR 8TH GRADE DANCE:

Students who arrive to the dance dressed inappropriately will not be permitted to enter the building. If a violation of the dress code occurs prior to or during the dance, the student will be asked to leave the school grounds for the remainder of the dance.

Boys: An appropriate manner of dress for boys would be a pair of slacks and dress shirt. A tie is recommended but not mandatory. A golf type shirt with a collar is an acceptable substitute for the dress shirt. Baggy jeans, shorts and t-shirts are not acceptable articles of clothing.

Girls: All dresses must meet the Frederick County Public Schools Code of Conduct. Dresses should cover the back over the bra strap. Straps should be at least three inches wide. Low cut or V-cut dresses are not permitted. Backless or spaghetti strap dresses are not permitted unless the dress includes a jacket, bolero, or shrug that must be worn at all times. Shawls will be discouraged.
